

Grant Award Procedures

HEART UK will be providing a number of annual grants up to £3,000 each, annually for a maximum of 3 years for any one grant. The purpose is to stimulate interest and activity in the medical profession, patients and members of the public in projects which will help achieve the objectives of the charity. These may include scientific and medical research, patient care and treatment or personal training and experience in cholesterol issues.

The procedures will be as follows:

- 1) The awards will be made by a committee consisting of:
 - The Chairman (Mr Ray Edwards)
 - The Medical Director (Dr Alan Rees)
 - The Chief Executive (Miss Jules Payne)
 - Prof Gordon Ferns
 - A cholesterol patient or member of the public

The Committee meet quarterly.

- 2) All applicants must be professional members or supporters of the organisation.

- 3) Initial submissions

They should include:

- (a) Description of the project and anticipated outcomes
- (b) Benefits of the project to HEART UK and/or to the applicant
- (c) Cost and timescales

- 4) The Committee may require further discussion/meetings before making its decision.

5) Grant winners will be expected to report the outcomes in a timely manner to the Awards Committee. They will be publicised via the HEART UK communication channels and also at HEART UK's annual scientific conference, if appropriate.

- 6) As funds are limited, there is no guarantee that all submissions can be supported.

- 7) Applications should be made as soon as possible.
